Eventide Circle restarted our "Change for a Change of Socks" on November 2nd for the First UMC Free Store. Up to this point we have donated 116 pairs of socks.

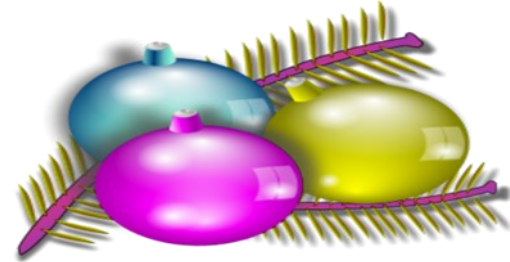
The change (\$80.00) we collected during the summer goes to the Foothills District UMW.
