Remembering Sand Creek

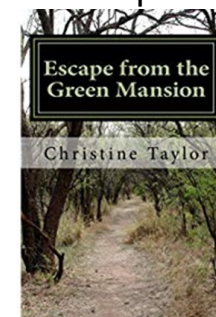
