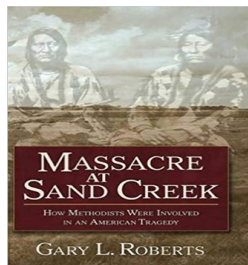

## Reading Program Announcement

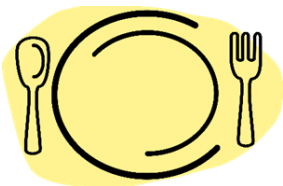

## \*\*Luncheon Date Change\*\*



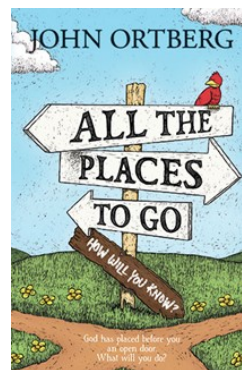
