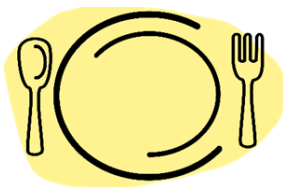
We will eat at noon. Drinks and table service will be provided. Please bring your favorite covered dishes to share, a lawn chair and any games or musical instruments.
