From the Pastors Desk

Dear friends,

You and I are *chosen*. 1 Peter 2:9 says, "You are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for God called you out of the darkness and into his wonderful light." What a privilege it is to be *chosen* by God! To know that we are wanted and loved and that our lives are meant to have meaning and purpose. This is such a critical piece of our Christian faith. Knowing the creator of the universe has chosen us, gives us a sense of belonging. Finding our true identities in Christ guides us through life's uncertainties. When others' comments or opinions wreck our selfunderstanding, knowing who we are through the love of our Creator, gives us the strength to stand firm. Even when we are at our worst, God's love for us in constant, nothing changes the fact that we are chosen by God.


