FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends,

There has been a lot of talk about some United Methodist Churches who have chosen to "disaffiliate" or leave the UMC. Some are leaving to form a different denomination and others are leaving to be an independent congregation. While I have spent time with God prayerfully reflecting on my calling and our identity as a congregation, I must say that I love the connectional part of being United Methodist. As part of our denomination, we have a reach that spans around the globe wherever there is a crisis or emergency; we have co-workers in the vineyard wherever we may travel or whenever we are working for Christ in the community. For example, many individuals from our congregation and our church's leadership as a whole support the missional work at First UMC. Perhaps you would appreciate hearing some of the impact you are having on that neighborhood.

Sitting at the free store earlier this week, I had someone come in that wanted to talk with me about the struggles they were having. By the time we

finished talking, she left feeling hopeful again and like God had lifted her up. A little later, David came in... we had been praying for his sister who had cancer surgery a few weeks ago. He was so thankful that we remembered her! And shared that her surgery was successful and that the doctor believes she will remain cancer free. Before worship on Sunday, someone stopped me in the parking lot for a word. That person said that they had been drug free since returning to the shelter this time. In fact, they were feeling so positive about it that they had recently destroyed all of their remaining paraphernalia. At our last community meal, I sat between four other individuals who had stayed at our shelter 8-10 years earlier. We laughed as we talked about the early days when we only had mats on the floor and trying to put together bed frames when they arrived. One of them recently returned to the shelter and was glad to know we were there for him when he needed to come back.

When I'm talking with the people in these scenarios, I see the hand of God at work. I feel God's sustaining presence and stand amazed at how God provides. From the outside, the neighborhood seems filled with overwhelming needs; from within our ministry, there is story after story of God meeting needs and providing all that matters for our neighbors. It has been said that you can't love your neighbor without loving your neighborhood. We also work to minister to those in Faith's neighborhood. Numerous people have shared stories with me about how our NA groups that meet here have impacted their lives. Likewise, everyone knows us for our drivein movies and "Hallow-weenies". 
