From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends,

It seems like forever since we have gathered together in the sanctuary and worshiped. Gradually, things are improving in our community and state. Many of our members have already received one or both vaccines. Thankfully, two weeks after your second vaccine, you should be immune to Covid-19. We have learned a lot about keeping ourselves and others safe. I am confident that as long as we continue to social distance in worship and wear our masks, we can safely return to worship beginning on Palm Sunday, March 28, 2021! We have not yet made a decision on Holy Week services, but the leadership team and I are rejoicing that we will be able to gather physically on Easter Sunday!

As we return to in-person worship, remember that not everyone has received their vaccine. This includes your pastor, most of the worship leaders, and our audio/visual team. I know that if you have been vaccinated, you will want to sit together, talk with each other, etc. However, there are a few things I want to emphasize:

1. We will observe safety protocols whenever we are in the church building. This includes both wearing masks and social distancing.
2. We will continue to live stream our worship services on Facebook and Webex.
3. Please be aware that those who have not been vaccinated will be extra intentional about staying at a distance, and it is not because we enjoy it, but because we want to keep ourselves and our families safe.

If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to ask me or any of our church leadership. If we don't have an answer, we will seek to get it for you.

This Lent we focus our worship on "Recovery": recovery of our individual lives, recovery of our sense of community, recovery of the workforce, recovery of our physical, spiritual, and mental health, etc. One of the choruses we sing each week is titled Make Us Holy, Make Us Whole:
