From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends,

I vividly remember last year at the end of February when everything began shutting down. I couldn't imagine not having worship in person for more than a week or two. Needless to say, recent months were completely unfathomable. When will we return to in person worship? When the Covid numbers come down and a significant number of our most vulnerable folks are vaccinated, when we are not risking health and safety by being together, when we can be in the same space with only the fear of the common cold or flu, we will return to in person worship. I personally know a church, not in our city but in southern Ohio, who had one person infect many others at church, eight became seriously ill, at least one has died. Our church's leadership wants to remain vigilant and do whatever possible to keep our congregation safe.

So here we are, a year later, preparing to enter Lent. I am planning for us to remain virtual throughout Lent and hope that I am incorrect again and we will be able to return to in person worship before Lent is over. **Ash Wednesday is on February 17th** this year. To experience the imposition of ashes, I will be available from **5-6pm at Faith UMC** by the upstairs / Sanctuary entrance. Congregants will have the option of:

pulling into the lot where I will meet them at their vehicle for the administering of communion and reception of ashes, or

exiting their vehicle and entering the sanctuary to spend time in meditation or prayer as well as the imposition of ashes and receiving of communion.

I will also be leading a weekly ***virtual study group on Wednesdays at 6:30pm***. It will use the same kind of system as we do on Sunday via WebEx. Church folks can call in by phone or connect via their computer. If it's not too complicated, we will share it on Face Book as well. The Lenten book we will be using is entitled ***Near the Cross: A Lenten Journey of Prayer by Kenneth H Carter***. If you are interested in participating in this study group or would simply like a copy of the book, please let me or the church office know so that the right number can be purchased. *Copies may be picked up on Ash Wednesday between 5-6pm or on Sunday, February 14th between 9:30-11:30am at Faith Church.*

Our Lenten worship services will focus on healing: physically, communally, mentally, environmentally, and Holy / wholly. Where could your life be improved or more whole? Jesus came to bring healing. Not only did he heal many during his earthly ministry, but he gave his own life that we might know the healing power of forgiveness. Included in this newsletter is the information about how to watch services online or by phone if you are having problems with or do not use Face Book. Also included is information about connecting for the study group.

Stay warm and stay safe while we wait for God to gather us inside the church again.
