My Life and Lesser Catastrophes written by Christina Schofield, Mission Emphasis: Spiritual Growth. Tentative meeting date: September 27, 2021.

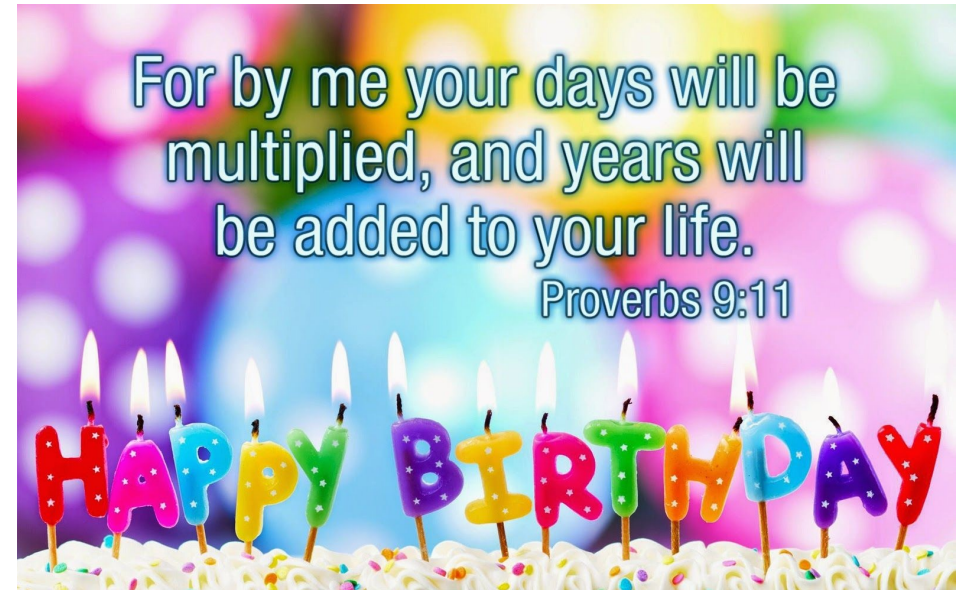
