FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends,

It's hard to believe that we are already in October! The days and nights are definitely cooler with less hours of sunshine. Pumpkins and mums are everywhere! In a few weeks, we will be passing out "Halloweenies" in the parking lot (last year, we went through 600!) and preparing for Thanksgiving. As with many years, Advent begins the following Sunday.
